Tranquillity is assured from your exclusive residence perched high above Fewa Tal Lake capturing the undisturbed views the length of the Annapurna Himal.

Accessible is only by boat *The Retreat* is located on a treed plateau off the southern shore of the Lake and surrounded not only by Himalayan views but also those of traditional Nepalese farmers, their daily life amidst paddy fields, planting, harvest and chores of the day. As you'd imagine the pace of life is relaxed and in tune with its surroundings.

Your private gardens and treed terraces offer an uninterrupted panorama of the lake with a cool breeze whilst before you are the changing hues of the Himalayas. Machapuchhare (The Fish Tale) and half dozen other 7,000 meter peaks are in view of your living room & doorstep.

With Pokhara as a distant eco across the water the sun, stars and mountains are your companions whilst your private boat and boatman completes the journey to lakeside just 20 minutes away. Nature was the inspiration of *The Retreat* from its hand cut stone, slate, timber, marble and mud construction to its conch-shell shaped design where every room has its own view of water and mountains.

Comfort is complete with lounge, dining and bedroom furnishings, carpet and marble floors, mains power supply, a complete kitchen - marble top benches and fresh spring water plus house servants to assist with meals & laundry as required.

The Retreat offers two stories and four bedrooms whilst the top floor is a 360 degree view meditation room with a private balcony. Overall it accommodates 6-8 people comfortably and includes a lounge room, dining room, indoor / outdoor bathroom, kitchen and pantry plus servants quarters. Fully furnished *The Retreat* just awaits you.

With home help on offer it's your choice to cook or sit out in the garden, read, relax potter around or take a walk into the surrounding hills and take in the view whilst a meal is prepared or a cup of tea is brewed.

How to get there:

To Pokhara Lakeside - By Domestic Flight / Private Car or Bus from Kathmandu

Lakeside to *The Retreat* - Private Boat - 20 minutes from Lakeside Pokhara

Items to bring: Personal effects, Towel, Food items

Note: Fridge and Pantry is provided but food supplies are not. However a basic menu of traditional Nepalese foods can be prepared if required both vegetarian or with meat. Prior notice should be given if catering is preferred. Pokhara provides a good range of supermarkets, bakeries and vegetable stalls to gather all that you'd require.
